

Dear Wisconsin Bankers Association Member,

The Wisconsin Bankers Foundation (WBF) is pleased to announce the launch of our annual Spring Scholarship program!

This program is open to applicants from two groups:

1: Graduating high school seniors who will be furthering their education at a Wisconsin state-accredited college, university, or state-operated technical school.

2: Individuals who are employed by or have a parent or guardian employed by a Wisconsin Bankers Association member. Eligible applicants may be a high school senior, an adult returning to college, or a current college student.

All applicants may plan to enroll on a full- or part-time basis, but must show proof of enrollment for a minimum of eight (8) credits. *Note:* students planning to attend a government military academy or privately run trade school are **not** eligible to apply.

Completed applications **must** be submitted **no later** than **Friday, April 2, 2021**.

Four awards of \$2,000 each will be given to qualified applicants. Selection criteria include:

- Scholastic and academic achievement
- Demonstration of financial literacy capabilities and resources
- Ability to articulate career plans
- Extracurricular activities
- Community involvement
- Other work experience
- Having a career goal in the financial services industry
